Important Claims Processing Updates

March 1, 2013

The following changes will be effective April 8, 2013:

X-rays for Root Canal Procedures

In accordance with State Regulations 8:3 (a) coverage shall include the pre-op and completion x-rays, Passport will consider a pre-op and post-op x-ray taken for root canals as inclusive to treatment. These x-rays will not be reimbursed separately.

Any additional x-rays taken will be denied unless deemed medically necessary. The denied x-rays will need to be appealed by contacting the Appeals Coordinator at:

D2950 – post and core build-up

This procedure is covered for all teeth.

D5820 and D5821 – interim partials

No prior authorization will be required. However, a narrative will be required for prepayment review.

D0220 and D0230 – periapical x-rays

These codes require a tooth number, so please provide the tooth number on the claim form. Otherwise, the procedures will be denied.
