Background:

Passport does not require Community Mental Health Centers to submit requests for authorization to provide Targeted Case Management for children with Severe Emotional Disorders (SED). Also, effective December 1, 2014, Passport no longer requires authorization to provide Targeted Case Management for adults with Severe Mental Illness (SMI).
