## Targeted Case Management Update

To: Passport Outpatient (non-CMHC) Behavioral Health Providers

### **Background:**

On 9/16/14, Governor Steven L. Beshear signed the Emergency Kentucky Administrative Regulations and started the Ordinary Kentucky Administrative Regulation process regarding the new coverage provisions and requirements for Targeted Case Management. We look forward to our members having the opportunity to obtain these valuable services. Please see the guidelines below for the provision of these services.

### **Provider Action Needed:**

1. Please ensure that you are contracted to provide these services. You may need to obtain a single case agreement to provide these services if you have already received your Medicaid Provider number, but are still completing the contracting, credentialing, and loading process. If you have successfully joined the provider network and are a provider type that is eligible to provide targeted case management, please verify that these services are included in the list of services you are contracted to provide.
2. Currently, ALL TYPES OF TARGETED CASE MANAGEMENT WILL REQUIRE PRIOR AUTHORIZATION. Please complete an e-Services Outpatient Request Form within the first two weeks of beginning the provision of the service.
3. Providers of case management and their supervisors (if practicing under supervision) will need to have successfully completed case management training approved by the Department for Behavioral Health, Developmental and Intellectual Disabilities as outlined in the 907 KAR 15:050, Section 4.
4. Targeted Case Management is an available service for Individuals with:
  - Substance Use Disorders (SUD)
  - Co-Occurring Mental Health Disorders for Chronic or Complex Physical Health Conditions (CCC)
  - Severe Emotional Disability (SED)
  - Severe Mental Illness (SMI)

A. Targeted case management can be provided by enrolled Kentucky Medicaid providers – individual practitioners, providers groups, or licensed organizations – that meet Kentucky criteria for providing case management in the 907 KAR 15:050.

45-EP, Community Support Associate under the Supervision of a Licensed Professional, Temporary EPSDT Benefit until 7/1/15. (Note: the billing supervisor provider type is still recorded appropriately. A separate rendering provider modifier to reflect the service

being provided by a Community Support Associate is not needed because it is understood as this is the only provider type that should be billing temporarily through EPSDT.)

D. Code Used for Service: T2023, Targeted Case Management per Month

E. Modifier Types:

HF: Substance Use Disorder

TG: Co-Occurring Mental Health Disorders for Chronic or Complex Physical Health Conditions

UA: Children with SED

HE: Adults with SMI

F. Also include Modifier Type of the rendering provider providing the service, such as U4 to indicate the Certified Social Worker Provider Type. The rendering information would be the supervisor including their NPI and taxonomy in Box 24J on the CMS-1500 Form.(Please see Passport eNews communication from 10/6/14 for more information)

G. Lastly, include the modifier to indicate whether the service was provided to a child or an adult for the Substance Use Disorder Targeted Case Management and Co-Occurring Mental Health Disorders for Chronic or Complex Physical Health Conditions Targeted Case Management:

HA: Child or Adolescent

HB: Adult

H. Please note, when the service is being provided as a temporary EPSDT benefit by a community support associate, modifier EP must be the first modifier entered on box 24D of the CMS-1500 Form. This would be followed by the modifier to indicate the type of targeted case management being provided such as HF (to indicate Substance Use Disorders), and lastly, the modifier to indicate whether the services was provided to a child or adolescent. (Again, please see Passport eNews communication from 10/6/14 for more information about completing the CMS-1500 Form.)

Additional directives will be provided for the Community Support Associates under the supervision of a licensed professional once their organization has obtained their Behavioral Health Service Organization (BHSO) licensure and the BHSO has completed the licensure and credentialing process with both the Kentucky Department of Medicaid Services and Passport. The service will no longer need to be provided through the temporary EPSDT benefit at that point.
