DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS What documentation should be submitted?	<p>Complete physical exam, including but not limited to: height, weight, BMI, vital signs, history & physical, review of systems, appropriate screening tests, immunizations administered, all anticipatory guidance given, including but not limited to the following topics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Smoking cessation • Avoiding alcohol and/or drugs • Good nutrition • The importance of safety belts • Wearing motorcycle, bicycle, skateboard helmets • Smoke detectors • Fall prevention • Safe water heater temperatures • Sexually transmitted disease prevention • Unintended pregnancy/birth control • Regular dental visits/dental care • Safe storage or removal of firearms • Physical activity/fitness • Limit fat and cholesterol • Adequate calcium intake (women)
