OBJECTIVE Purpose of Measure:	To ensure child members age 12 months to 19 years see a PCP at least annually
ELIGIBLE POPULATION Which members are included?	Members age 12 months to 19 years as of December 31st of the measurement year
STANDARD OF CARE	Children and adolescents should have a PCP visit at least annually.
NCQA ACCEPTED CODES	<i>Please see code table.</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Children 12 months to 6 years should have a PCP visit during the measurement year.</li> <li>• Children and adolescents ages 7 to 19 years should have a PCP visit during the measurement year or year prior to the measurement year.</li> </ul>
DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS What documentation should be submitted?	Complete physical exam, including but not limited to: height, weight, BMI percentile, vital signs, history & physical, review of systems, age-appropriate screening tests, immunizations administered, all specific topics for which anticipatory guidance was given, etc.
