OBJECTIVE Purpose of Measure:	To identify members who are due for an immunization
ELIGIBLE POPULATION Which members are included?	Adolescent members who turned 13 years of age during the measurement year
STANDARD OF CARE What immunizations should be administered?	One (1) meningococcal vaccine between the member's eleventh (11 th) and thirteenth (13 th) birthdays. One (1) Tdap or Td vaccine between the member's tenth (10 th) and thirteenth (13 th) birthdays.
NCQA ACCEPTED CODES	<i>Please see code table.</i>
DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS What documentation should be submitted?	If a vaccine was administered: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A note indicating the name of the immunization and date given, or • A <i>signed</i> certificate of immunization prepared by an authorized health care provider or agency that includes the type of immunization and date administered. If a vaccine was <i>not</i> given: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Documentation of anaphylactic reaction to the vaccine or its components
