### Background

The 2016 Behavioral Health HEDIS<sup>®</sup> measures address children, adolescents, and adults who are on antipsychotic medications. These measures are looking to see if members are receiving, at a minimum, yearly screenings for diabetes and cardiovascular issues while on antipsychotic medications.

To comply the Behavioral Health HEDIS<sup>®</sup> measures for 2016 please complete and/or refer Passport Health Plan members who are on an antipsychotic medications for either a fasting blood glucose or HbA1c and an LDL (calculated or direct) screening.
