



All Ordering, Referring, Prescribing and Attending Providers Must Be Enrolled In Kentucky Medicaid

Background:

The Kentucky Department for Medicaid Services (DMS) has notified all Kentucky Managed Care Organizations that, in accordance with 907 KAR 3:005 and 42 CFR 455.410, all Ordering, Referring, Prescribing and Attending (ORP) providers must be enrolled in Kentucky Medicaid and eligible on the date(s) of service in order for a claim to be reimbursed. Historically, only rendering and billing providers have been verified to have a Kentucky Medicaid Identification (MAID) number.

Beginning February 1, 2017, Passport Health Plan (Passport) will be verifying the MAID for all ORP providers. The following physician types are eligible to be ORP providers:

- 60 – Dentist
- 64 – Physician
- 74 – Nurse Anesthetist
- 77 – Optometrist
- 78 – Certified Nurse Practitioner
- 80 – Podiatrist
- 95 – Physician Assistant

Provider Action Needed:

Effective February 1, 2017, all claims (UB-04 and HCFA) submitted involving an ORP physician must include ORP information, including NPI and/or taxonomy (if applicable), or it will be denied.

Specifically, all services billed by any provider involved in the care of a member must include the appropriate ORP provider(s), listed above.
